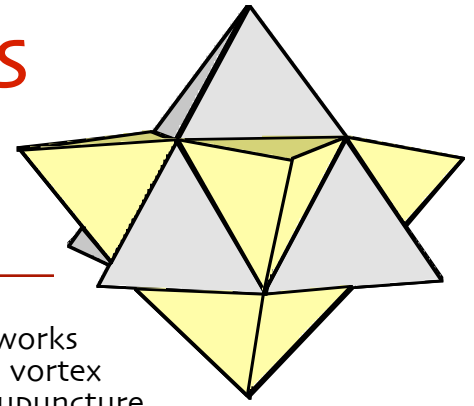


# The Merkaba of Oneness

## Based on the Geometry of the Angels



Based upon the geometry of the Gate of Grace, this sacred geometry works with the life force structures found in the human body. When it spins, vortex induced vibrations interact with the body's meridians in a way that acupuncture or light diodes cannot. Because the Merkaba of Oneness is an intention machine, it does more than move energy. Wellness depends on more than just energy. The spirit, mind, emotions and cells themselves have been shown to be carriers of consciousness, thus interacting with what we call the "power of intent." Because the vortex-induced vibrations can interact with any of the four bodies, carrying with it the directions of intention, the Merkaba of Oneness can be used in a multi-purpose fashion to restore all of the bodies to their natural state.

### USES OF THE MERKABA OF ONENESS:

1. Induce oneness within self, by activating the Shekinah and Metatron vibrations inherent within.
2. Spin the merkaba above the head. or the heart chakra, to address wellness.
3. Help manifest an intent.
4. Insert either the Shekinah Oil, Metatron Oil, or Christ Oil, by suspending the bottle in the center, to bring harmony to the body, mind, or emotions.
5. Create sacred space in a room or a surrounding. It's a structure of beauty.
6. Connect more easily to your Higher Self by fostering a peaceful environment.
7. Remove negative vibrations from a room or a surrounding.
